

STATE ACCIDENT REPORTING

In addition to recording the DOT recordable crashes, many states have requirements for reporting a crash. The threshold for reporting is different from FMCSA requirements in many instances. To insure that you are in compliance with all accident requirements, we are providing the agency that crashes must be reported to without providing information on the amounts. To insure you are in compliance following a crash, we recommend that you contact these agencies to determine if a accident report to that jurisdiction is required.
