**IMPORTANT NOTES TO ALL DRIVERS - Read Carefully.**

- 1) All Drivers must be pre-registered and present for Check-In, Written Exam and Orientation on Friday morning at 6:00 a.m. to be eligible to compete in the Championships.
- 2) Drivers are expected to read and comply with the Ground Rules in the Program Book.
- 3) Drivers should report to their Class Captains for periodic roll calls and further instructions.
- 4) All Drivers will have a walk-thru of the driving course Friday or Saturday morning. This is your opportunity to view the exterior only of the equipment. Drivers will not be allowed to walk around the equipment at the start line. NO questions will be permitted during the walk-through.
- 5) All Drivers are expected to attend all official functions of the Championships unless permission is given from their Class Captain. (emergencies only)
- 6) Written Examination Questions and Answers will be posted at a public location during the Championships
- 7) All scores displayed during the skills competition are unofficial. Audited individual score sheets will be available from your class captian after the Awards Banquet.
- 8) No Alcohol consumption at any time during competition on Friday or Saturday and no alcohol is permitted until the conclusion of the Awards Banquet.
