#### WINNERS ANNOUNCED IN MISSOURI TRUCK DRIVING CHAMPIONSHIPS

JOPLIN - With nearly 570 in the audience looking on, **Lawrence O'Neal** of Festus, Missouri, a driver for FedEx National LTL of St. Charles, Missouri, gained the distinguished title of Grand Champion in the 2008 Missouri Truck Driving Championships. By outscoring his competitors in a written examination, a pretrip inspection, a personal interview and a truck driving obstacle course where he proved superior driving skills, he triumphed. The competition was held in Joplin, Missouri at the John Q. Hammons Convention Center, this past weekend, June 6 & 7, 2008.

Lawrence O'Neal succeeded by placing first in the Twin Trailers Class in the annual safe driving competition sponsored by the Missouri Motor Carriers Association and its Council of Safety Supervisors, which attracted 181 of the state's top truck drivers.

O'Neal received the Grand Trophy and the opportunity to compete in the American Trucking Association's 2008 National Truck Driving Championships in Houston, TX on August 19 through 23, 2008, for the selection of the nation's top professional truck drivers.

First, second and third place winners in all eight classes of competition were honored and received trophies at the Awards Banquet on Saturday evening in Joplin, at the John Q. Hammons Convention Center. The first place winners will all be competing in their particular class of competition at the National Truck Driving Championships in Houston, in August.

The "Pre-Trip Inspection" award for the highest score in assuring that a vehicle is in safe and efficient operating condition before leaving on a trip went to **Chad Daniel** of West Point, GA, a driver for Prime, Inc. in Springfield, MO.

The "Team Championship" went to Wal-Mart Transportation, of St. James, MO for having the highest average team score in the competition.

The keynote speaker for the evening was Jan Skouby, Motor Carrier Services Director, Missouri Department of Transportation.
