

A few years ago the Council of Safety Supervisors and the Truck Driving Championship Committee decided that moving the event to a different location each year would give better exposure to different areas of the state.

The Championships will be held in Joplin in 2011 and in Kansas City in 2012. The Committee is reviewing a site for 2013 in St. Louis.

About the event: The drivers were interviewed by industry experts, and inspected their vehicles under the watchful eyes of government investigators. The drivers then completed a skill driving course that contained obstacles that they encounter in their normal daily activities. The drivers attempted to complete all these problems within a time limit. The winners earned the right to proclaim for the next year that they are the best of the best from the State of Missouri.

To attend the Championships a driver must have been with their company as a professional truck driver for one year and most importantly been accident free during that time period.

The top place finishers for each of the 9 class of competitions will proceed to Columbus, Ohio in August to participate in the National Truck Driving Championships sponsored by the American Trucking Association. They will be challenged once more at the National's to try to claim the title of the "best of the best" after competing against almost 400 winners of state competitions.



Course Chairman Rick Hinkle explained the Wabash Skills Driving Course – This was the first time the drivers saw the course. Points for successful completion of each obstacle were allotted. Each class had a time element and points were docked for not completing the course within the time limit.

A new method of recording scores was implemented this year, so the importance of consistency in scoring was stressed.





Drivers this year were interviewed by an industry safety consultant and a lead trainer at a truck driving school on their conduct, knowledge and attitude as they answered a specific set of questions.


Each driver completed a pretrip inspection under the watchful eye of investigators from the Missouri Department of Transportation's Motor Carrier Service's Enforcement Division.

The drivers had to properly wear their seat belt and enter and exit the vehicle using the three point process. Drivers had a time limit for successful completion of the course as well.















Obstacle #3 RIGHT TURN RIGHT SIDE REAR MOST TRAILER TIRE PROBLEM All Classes








Obstacle #4 LEFT SIDE STEER TIRE SCORE **PADS PROBLEM** All Classes


