
2009 SPRING SAFETY CONFERENCE AND AWARDS LUNCHEON



To assist in the quest for applications for technology, compliance and training the Missouri Motor Carriers Association's Council of Safety Supervisors designed a two day event. The *Spring Safety Conference* was developed to showcase experts in their respective fields of safety and maintenance and provide current information on the top subjects of the day.

The 2009 conference covered safety and maintenance topics on sleep apnea, driver retention, biodiesel, tire management, roadside inspections, EPA Smartway, and updates from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. MoDOT Motor Carrier Services presented an update on Compliance Safety Analysis 2010. Also available was information on managing catastrophic claims and how to prepare for a deposition.

At the end of Day One an evening networking reception provided an opportunity to meet with other safety and maintenance professionals.

The conference concluded with the annual *Safety Awards Luncheon*.


