MISSOURI TRUCKING ASSOCIATION ANNUAL SAFETY AWARDS

Branson, MO --The 2015 Missouri Trucking Association (MoTA) Annual SuperTech Competition, Safety & Maintenance Conference and Expo was attended by nearly 350 Safety and Maintenance Professionals and included 25 speakers. The two day event was sponsored by both the MoTA Council of Safety Supervisors and the MoTA Technology and Maintenance Council at the Hilton Branson Convention Center, Branson, Missouri, February 4 & 5. The event featured 23 exhibit booths.

For full-time heavy-duty truck technicians, the SuperTech Competition was held on Wednesday. A Tech Training Fair was held Thursday morning followed by an Awards Luncheon where the competitors were honored.

The conference was highlighted by the 68th annual Safety Awards Banquet honoring the trucking industry's finest safety, maintenance and driving professionals with over 200 company officials in attendance.

For thirty-four of the last thirty-five years, the **Missouri Trucking Association** has received the coveted Summa Cum Laude Award from American Trucking Associations' State Association Recognition Program for effectively fostering and promoting highway safety programs within Missouri for the greater good of the trucking industry and all highway users. Accepting the award was Todd Smith, 2014 Chairman of the Council of Safety Supervisors.

Four major fields recognized -- the Fleet Safety Contest; the Missouri Drivers of the Month; 2014 Driver of the Year; the Safety Professional of the Year -- shared the spotlight at the banquet.

The 2014 Missouri Driver of the Year is **Russell Smith**, a driver for **Transport Distribution Company of Joplin, Missouri**. Mr. Smith has been a professional driver for 19 years and has amassed over two million miles. Captain David Earney of the Missouri State Highway Patrol presented Mr. Smith with a custom designed keepsake ring and framed certificate from the Missouri Trucking Association for his excellence in highway safety and maintenance operations.

The drivers recognized for outstanding performance, each were presented with a commemorative engraved Browning Knife from the Missouri Trucking Association. Introducing each of the drivers and technicians was Jim Wingfield of Tri-State Motor Transit, Joplin, MO and Chairman of the MoTA Board of Directors.

The winner in the "Local Division" was **D & D Sexton, Carthage, MO.** Honorable mention in the local division went to **ABF Freight System, Fort Smith, AR**

In the "Over the Road, Up to One Million Miles" category, the winner was **Twehous Excavating Company, Jefferson City, MO.** Honorable mention in the Up to One Million Miles category went to **Rooney Trucking, Inc., Polo, MO.**

The plaque winner in the "Over the Road, One to Five Million Miles" category was **Opies Transport, Eldon, MO**; honorable mention in this category went to **Frontier Leasing, Joplin, MO**.
